**Book buyer** - chooses books for the walks and after the walk, settles finances with the seller (usually Family Christian Book Store)

**Team selection** - keeps track of who is eligible for positions and works with the Lay Directors to fill teams

**Secretary** - keeps minutes of meetings

**Gathering Coordinator** - contacts Emmaus members to schedule and organize a gathering at that church

**Registrar** - receives applications and sends acceptance letters to the pilgrims and sponsors; works with Lay Director to see that all pilgrims' food and physical needs are met; keeps data base of pilgrims' information
