The administrator will verify that you have been on a fourth day event such as the Great Banquet or Walk to Emmaus and you will be added. We ask that you not use this site for soliciting funds for anything other than Emmaus. Any items posted that are deemed inappropriate will be removed by the administrator of the site. This is a great way to stay in touch with your Emmaus brothers and sisters.

The GIAEC email account is Indyemmaus@gmail.com. This email is used only for Emmaus related items and for sending out an electronic version of the Go Fourth Newsletter.

The Go Fourth newsletter contain community information. Content varies from newsletter to newsletter. They are normally published quarterly and distributed through email. Copies are available on IndyEmmaus.org. They are sent out electronically, however, if you like paper, for a \$10 fee the Go Fourth can be mailed via US Mail.
